Their unique allergen-free products were born of necessity after a pesticide poisoning caused severe health problems for the family. Coping with these health problems led them in a diligent search for quality, natural, fragrance-free replacements for the many perfumed and synthetic products they could no longer use. Disappointed with the natural products they could buy, they eventually developed their own natural skin care line, bath products and insect repellent alternatives.

THE CHALLENGE. In the Potters Hand had an opportunity to expand and grow their production business and add retail space for their products. The company in the process of moving facilities from Wildrose, ND, to a site location in Crosby, ND.
