To ensure that QQP maintained its high level of service and commitment to its core values, they contacted SD Manufacturing and Technology Solutions (MTS) to help evaluate their processes and increase cohesiveness within their team.

MEP CENTER'S ROLE. To do this, MTS facilitated a Value Stream Mapping project to examine QQP's processes and develop a plan for improvement.

To increase the success of the recommendations from the VSM project, QQP also brought in MTS to help the QQP team understand how to work more effectively. To do this, MTS Business Advisor Stuart Giere employed the Six Types of Working Genius program, for which he is a certified facilitator.

Through individual assessments and team sessions, including the executive team, the whole QQP team was able to better align their activities and work more productively by understanding their own "geniuses, competencies, and frustrations," thereby increasing productivity and job satisfaction and decreasing burnout among its team.
